

Doctrine of Distinguishing Grace

1. There is saving grace.

- *Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.*

2. There is witnessing grace.

- *Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.*

3. There is traveling grace.

- *Acts 15:40 And Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God.*

4. There is serving grace.

Romans 1:5 By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name:

5. There is sustaining grace in times of sickness.

2 Corinthians 12:9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.

6. There is restraining grace.

- *Genesis 20:6 I also withheld thee from sinning against me.*
