

Doctrine of a Holy Kiss

Is *Scripture* Violated?

1. Is *Scripture* violated when Christians do not greet one another with a holy kiss?
 - *Romans 16:16 Salute one another with an holy kiss. The churches of Christ salute you.*
 - *1 Corinthians 16:20 All the brethren greet you. Greet ye one another with an holy kiss.*
 - *2 Corinthians 13:12 Greet one another with an holy kiss.*
 - *1 Thessalonians 5:26 Greet all the brethren with an holy kiss.*

2. Is *Scripture* violated when Christian women wear gold, pearls and braid their hair?
 - *1 Timothy 2:9 In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array.10 But (which becometh women professing godliness) with good works.*

3. Is *Scripture* violated when Christian women pray, or testify, or teach Sunday classes in the Church?
 - *1 Timothy 2:11 Let the woman learn in silence with all subjection. 12 But I suffer not a woman to teach, nor to usurp authority over the man, but to be in silence. [Note. At what age does a boy become a man? What about women missionaries who teach men in tribal areas?]*

4. Is *Scripture* violated when Christian women pray with their head uncovered?
 - *1 Corinthians 11:5 But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with her head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven. 6 For if the woman be not covered, let her also be shorn: but if it be a shame for a woman to be shorn or shaven, let her be covered.*
 - *1 Corinthians 11:13 Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered?*
