

Doctrine of What is Impossible

1. It is impossible that death could hold Jesus Christ in the grave.
 - *Acts 2:24 Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.*
2. It is impossible for God to have a rival deity.
 - *Deuteronomy 32:39 See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand. 40 For I lift up my hand to heaven, and say, I live for ever.*
3. It is impossible for God to die.
 - *Psalms 90:2 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou art God.*
4. It is impossible for God to lie.
 - *Hebrews 6:18 That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us.*
5. It is impossible for demons to resist the authority of Christ.
 - *Matthew 17:18 And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour.*

Special Note.

Nothing is impossible for the person who believes in God, and is motivated by faith to do God's will.

- *Matthew 17:19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? 20 And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.*
6. It is impossible for Christ to leave those for whom He has died, and the Holy Spirit has regenerated, based on God's electing grace.
 - *Hebrews 13:5 Let your conversation be without covetousness; and be content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee.*

7. It is impossible for God to tempt a soul sin.

- *James 1:13 Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempteth he any man: 14 But every man is tempted, when he is drawn away of his own lust, and enticed.*

8. It is impossible for God to be less than God. He cannot change.

- *Malachi 3:6 For I am the Lord, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.*
- *Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.*

9. It is impossible for God to learn anything knew. God does not come into knowledge.

- *Psalms 139:1 O Lord, thou hast searched me, and known me. 2 Thou knowest my down sitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. 3 Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways. 4 For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O Lord, thou knowest it altogether.*

10. It is impossible to fool God.

- *Numbers 32:23 But if ye will not do so, behold, ye have sinned against the Lord: and be sure your sin will find you out.*

11. It is impossible for God to be illogical, and act in a manner inconsistent with His nature, such as creating a rock He cannot move.

- *Isaiah 55:8 For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord. 9 For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.*

12. It is impossible for God to change His decretive will.

- *Daniel 4:35 And all the inhabitants of the earth are reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and among the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest thou?*

13. It is impossible for God to judge unrighteously.

- *Psalms 19:9 The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.*
