

Doctrine of Spiritual Leadership

Principles of Personal Application

1. Spiritual leaders are to stand resolutely on the “walls” of divine responsibility and not come down from the great work to compromise with evil and error.
2. Motivational leadership is essential in order to unite people into action.
3. Provide an encouragement that motivates a sense that every worker is being valued and cared for.
4. Never underestimate the importance of praise and encouragement.
5. When people refuse to work in the ordinary laboring ministries of the Church, however important and high up in society, they are not only letting down their fellow members, they are actually dishonoring “*their Lord*”.
6. Efficient organization is vital.
7. Leadership must be pro-active in establishing spiritual and practical defences.
8. In the management of people, the Word of the Lord and the work of the Lord must never be undermined by worldly power and influence. When the honour of the Lord is at stake there are times when spiritual leaders need to be extremely firm.
9. In dealing with people, there are times when decisive and disciplined action is required for the honour of the Lord and the work of the Lord.
